All children across the country will be completing their SATs the week beginning 13th May 2024.

KS2 SATs are mandatory tests from the National Curriculum assessment programme.

They are marked externally, and the results sent to schools.



- Final judgements will be reported to parents at the same time as the other assessment results


How to help your child:


